Rev. Wendy will continue weekly Bible Studies through the fall on Tuesdays at 2:00 p.m. The fall study guide will be distributed on September 5.


Peace & Global Offering

God's plans are not always what we'd expect. but God knows what He is doing and we can trust Him to be Good.


September 10 Matthew 18:15-20 God is with us whenever we gather in His name.
