The Advent candles we light each week serve as a reminder of the increasing light in our lives as we draw nearer to the celebration of Christ's birth.

As we come together in worship and fellowship throughout this Advent season, let us keep these Gospel messages close to our hearts. Together, we can find joy and hope in the midst of the Northern Minnesota winter, just as the people of old found hope in the promise of the Messiah.

Join us for our Advent services and activities, where we will explore these Gospel themes in greater depth and celebrate the birth of our Savior. Let us also take this opportunity to share the warmth of Christ's love with our community through acts of kindness and generosity.

May your December be filled with the peace, love, and joy that only Christ can bring.

#### December 24 - LOVE Christmas Eve - Sunday






